Risto Malcheski is full Professor of Mathematics and Statistics at the Faculty for informatics at FON University in Skopje, Republic of Macedonia. He studied undergraduate, Masters and Doctoral studies at the Faculty of Natural Sciences and Mathematics at University Ss. Cyril and Methodius in Skopje. He completed Master studies by making the master's thesis Subnormal operators, and Doctoral studies with Doctoral dissertation "Contribution to the theory of *n*-normed spaces". His research interests are in the fields of functional analysis and methodology of teaching mathematics. He is the author of 40 papers in the field of functional analysis, 34 papers in the field of methodology of teaching mathematical journals. He is a reviewer of Math Reviews and member of the editorial boards of several mathematical journals.

Prof. Malcheski is author of 52 mathematics books, from which 17 are University books and monographs. Part of his professional engagement is focused on the development of talented students in Mathematics in Macedonia, for which he wrote 55 professional papers and around twenty textbooks and Mathematic books. He was part of organizational and program board of several Balkan, Junior Balkan and Students Mathematical Olympiads and he is one of the founders of Junior Balkan Mathematical Olympiad. He is member of MASSEE and the Union of Mathematicians of Macedonia for which he was the President from January 1999 to May 2004.
